Insider Threat Summit

7–9 September, 2015
Vienna, Austria

This workshop will bring together leaders from the nuclear community, as well as technical staff and managers to develop an understanding of the potential threats from malicious insiders as well as practical mitigation strategies.

Objectives include:

- Clarify the definition of insider threat, including common motivating factors
- Contrast and compare various mitigation strategies, including perspectives from the oil & gas, financial, and other industries
- Discuss high-profile case studies demonstrating the effectiveness of insider threat mitigation strategies
- Provide an international platform for leaders to share lessons learned and practical solutions

The Insider Threat Summit is in coordination with the World Institute for Nuclear Security's (WINS) two-day workshop, Executive Leadership for a Secure and Reliable Workforce. This event will take place at the same venue and will immediately follow the summit, taking place 10-11 September 2015.
