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What is radioactive source security?

A sustainable system that:

- **ensures** that radioactive sources are securely protected during their entire life cycle
- **can prevent, detect and respond** to nuclear security events involving radioactive material

IAEA Nuclear Security Series No 30-G Sustaining a Nuclear Security Regime includes **8 national** and **7 operational objectives** to support sustainable nuclear security and we will focus on one at each level:

- Developing human resources (National)

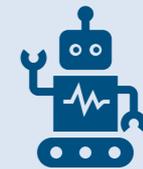

Why is it important to define competencies?

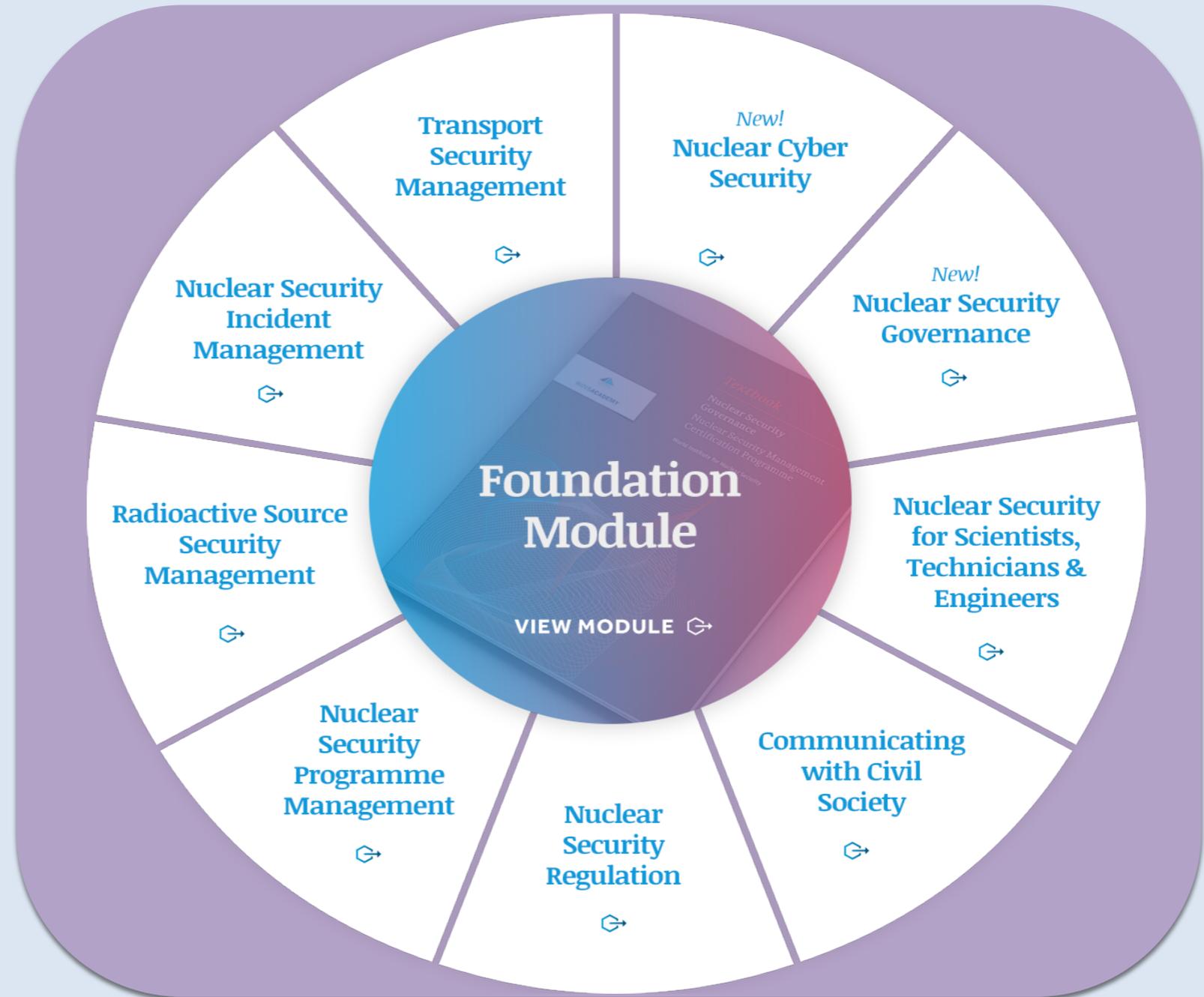
- **To meet** external regulatory requirements – whether explicit (SQEP) or implicit (plans and arrangements)
- **To meet** internal organization requirements
- **To attract** well qualified candidates for positions of importance
- **To demonstrate and maintain** public confidence
- Others?

How can 'certification' contribute to competence development and maintenance?



Who could have a role in defining the required competencies?

How can 'certification' contribute to competence development and maintenance?

- It can **measure achievement** of a learner against a defined curriculum
- It can **demonstrate an acceptable level** as defined by a particular industry or sector
- It could **provide evidence** to a regulator that an individual covered by the regulatory framework has **achieved a mandated level of competence** that contributes to the wider plans and arrangements the subject of the licence
- It can **provide evidence** to a regulator at the organizational level that there is a programme in place **to support effective security**
