You spoke. We listened.

The WINS Academy continually strives to improve the experience of our alumni. In order to adequately understand the opinions, ideas and wishes for improvement of WINS Academy Alumni, we regularly conduct surveys.

We're very pleased to share the results of our September 2020 survey, focusing on potential improvements to the Alumni Network, perspectives on the re-certification process and online examinations, and interest in digital badging and further engagement strategies.







The clear majority believe a digital badge would be beneficial for them; of this majority, nearly half indicated that an e-badge would enhance the recognition/legitimacy of their WINS Academy Certification. More than a quarter indicated that an e-badge would simply be more accessible and easier to use.

Survey Demographics The survey participants were generally demographically representative of all WINS Academy Alumni and came from a variety of organisations and specialisations. Importantly, 30% of respondents were female, which is in line with our gender parity goal of 30% enrolment in the WINS Academy programmes.

ALUMNI NETWORK ON THE WINS

The responses clearly show a positive attitude towards re-certification. Most alumni plan to re-certify, citing career development goals, increased credibility in the field, and the desire to improve their knowledge and keep up-to-date with the current developments in nuclear security, as well as a variety of other reasons. An overwhelming majority of alumni think taking another specialisation elective is the most efficient way to re-certify, whilst valuing the option of recertifying by providing evidence of

continued competence in nuclear security.

Alumni Network on the WINS website The majority of our respondents are members of the Alumni Network, demonstrating their enthusiasm for such a network. The average satisfaction rate was a healthy 7.9/10, which indicates room to grow and improve but also a strong foundation on which to build. Nevertheless, visits to the Alumni Network are not very frequent, with most respondents visiting only once per month.
